## **Lemon Trees and Berry Vines**

Once while living in central Texas, I planted a lemon tree — not a bad idea for south Texas. But this was central Texas, and I should have known better.

The first season found the tree loaded with lemons. "This is going to be easy," I thought. But the next winter was brutal. I potted the tree and brought it inside. The following spring I planted it again, but it never produced another lemon. Two years later it died.

Berry vines (and grape vines I have since learned) are much more hardy. Let the harsh weather come and do

what it will. The berry vines will be just fine.

Perhaps we think of ourselves as berry vines — able to endure almost anything life may throw our way. But the Bible — and life itself, eventually — paint a different picture. We are, in fact, more like lemon trees — able to flourish under the right conditions, but desperately in need of God's protection. A brief reading of Job 38-41 reminds us of just how weak we really are.

The good news is, God wants to be your Protector — if you will let Him (Mt 23:37). - WKing
