Lessons Learned from John the Baptist

Herod had laid hold of John and bound him, and put him in prison for the sake of Herodias, his brother Philip's wife, because John had said to him, "It is not lawful for you to have her." - Mt 14:3-4

This brief account from Matthew's gospel holds several lessons for those with an ear to hear.

We learn, for example, that faithful preaching of God's Word demands plainness of speech. Herod imprisoned John, and ultimately had him executed, because he perfectly understood the message. John did not mince words or hide the message behind positive 'spin'.

We also learn that some marriages violate God's will. Of course, John was addressing a specific situation from the Law of Moses; but Jesus has also prescribed specific laws concerning marriage, divorce, and remarriage (Mt 19:9). Faithful gospel preachers today will continue to teach what Jesus taught.

And finally, we learn that keeping wrong company is destructive. King Herod did not want John dead, but he felt compelled to yield to the sinful desires of others. Peer pressure can affect anyone.
