How God Defeated Satan

The short answer to the question of how God defeated Satan is rather easy. He sent His Son Jesus to die on the cross for our sins. Case closed. End of story.

But the story is much more involved than that. The sacrifice of Jesus was certainly a critical step in God's victory over Satan. But it was just one step of many.

Before Genesis one, before the creation of the universe, God had a plan in place to address a problem that hadn't even happened yet. The

problem was a wholesale rebellion against Him. The adversary was Satan – the devil, the accuser. And while we know little of his activities before Ge 1:1, he is called a liar and a murderer (Jn 8:44). From his first appearance in the Biblical narrative, (Ge 3), he has proven to be both.

The issue at stake: God is a perfectly righteous God and will not fellowship sin, not even a little bit. Yet Satan has persuaded us **all** to sin — to rebel against God. That rebellion is not a shift in loyalty from God to

Satan (at least not directly). Rather it is a shift of loyalty from God to **self**. Satan does not need us to fall before him and worship him. He is content with us worshipping ourselves. And he is very successful.

God's preemptive move against Satan was not simply to destroy him. That would have been a partial victory – but such a move would not have helped you and me. Instead, His move was The Plan – the scheme of redemption, the plan of salvation. It included creating a nation of people who would be loyal to Him (the church). Centuries of tutorial work (the Old Testament) prepared the way for this spiritual nation. And of course, The Plan included a Messiah – one who did live a perfect life, and thereby became a suitable sacrifice for the sins of humanity. But there is more.

This spiritual nation is comprised of those who have been, themselves, rebellious against God (all have sinned), yet have come to Him through the Messiah, Jesus (faith in Him, repentance from sins, and immersion in water – Mk 16:16, Ac 2:38). And these people (the Bible calls them Christians) are not righteous robots. They have been **forgiven** of their sins – not once, not three times, not seven times, but seventy times seven (Mt 18:22). That is, as often as we need God's forgiveness, He is faithful to forgive (1 Jn 1:9). He is, after all, a God of grace and mercy.

And that is how God defeated Satan. It matters not how many times Satan succeeds in leading us away from God, if we have a heart of humble repentance, God will forgive us. Satan simply cannot keep up with God's grace.

Even as Christians we may still feel broken at times – weak and worthless. But remember this one thing: never give up on God, for He will never give up on you.
